Abstract: Westerners must understand that the great Rasul (S) of Islam is loved by all Muslims and freedom lovers of the world. Insulting Mohammad Rasulullah(S) is insulting all Muslims. Insulting the Rasul (S) is insulting all Anbiya (as), human values, and amounts to undermining ethics. Rasulullah(S) is deeply revered by Muslims and any kind of visual depiction of him is forbidden in Islam. The caricatures of the sacred figures of Islam in question are seen by Muslims as offensive and Islamophobic because they are perceived to link Islam with terrorism. Anger of Muslims is also because of the anti-Islam media which is the source of impudence against our beloved Rasul(S) whom we hold so dear.

It is clear why the developed world would find it in their best interest to produce offensive material that creates negative feelings amongst the second largest population of the world. Isn't it sufficient that the alleged "War against Terror" has persecuted the Muslims globally on a scale never seen before? Israel and her illegitimate parents in the international Zionist establishment were able to produce a lot of the sponsorship (to maximum heights), which it benefited from throughout the Cold War. The reprinting of the cartoons in the name of "freedom of expression" has once again illustrated that the West is not ready to tolerate Islam and Muslims. The spirit of Crusades is burning alive and the role of the Church in this regard is paramount.

The Pope of the Roman Catholic Church, along with the leader of the Protestants, Archbishop of Canterbury, never played any role of guidance towards their disciples to refrain from hurting the sentiments of Muslims. Referring to the offensive cartoons of Rasulullah(S), first published in a Danish newspaper, at the ceremony by University of Evora for awarding Honorary Doctorate on the subject of "Material and Spiritual Service to Humanity" Evora, Portugal, on 12 February 2006, Aga Khan explained that it was more a "Clash of Ignorance" than a "Clash of Civilizations". By using the word "ignorance" he beautifully explained the approach of the stone-age-era since no civilization allows hurting human feelings. The Western world is demonstrating the mindset of the stone-age era with reference to Islam and Muslims. Their purposeful ignorance is more dangerous than a snake's venom. Due to this ignorance, the Muslim world is facing danger and it gives birth to a breed that believes that freedom of expression denotes the legal right to insult the divine personalities. Freedom of expression does not mean damaging human dignity, decency, and harmony in any society; it does not mean the freedom to insult.

Zionist Jews and Orthodox Christian think tanks are afraid of the spread of Islam around the world. They calculated well in advance that the next century was for Islam and hence adopted a strategy to crush the Muslims with all possible methods. Western governments hold aloft the banner of "freedom of speech" when it comes to insulting Muslims and Islam. The provocative moves by the Western media to insult and attack Islam is an old mission. Moreover, many Western countries keep silent on the war crimes committed by the Allied Forces in Iraq and Afghanistan. They even prevent Muslim women from wearing Hij'ab citing that it is sexist. With all possible methods they force Muslims to accept their definition of 'freedom', which is nothing but an insult and abuse of the laws of Islam.

The cartoons published are in contempt of the most divine personality to ever grace the earth. The media repeated the same attack as if they were trying to re-open an old wound when they argued in support of the published images. What can one say in response to this open declaration of enmity? Should we look on the other side, pretend to be deaf and maintain silence even when our hearts burn? By the honour of Rasulullah (S), our graves are dearer to us than the lust of the world and its affairs. The honour of our ancestors was in sacrifice for Rasulullah(S). There is no phrase that can cover all the great attributes of Rasulullah(S), and there are not enough words to describe his divine status — a loftiness that overwhelmed all and was decreed to be eternal.
